HOWLONG COUNTRY GOLF CLUB
MENS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS
CONDITIONS OF PLAY;

1. Each player must be affiliated with GA/NSWGA and be a financial member of the Howlong Country Golf Club..
2. The rules of golf as authorised by the Royal and Ancient and the United States Golf Association and the Local Rules shall apply.
3. The Championship will be decided by stroke play over four (4) rounds of eighteen (18) holes, played over four (4) days.
4. In the event of a tie for Club Champion (Scratch) there will be a play-off over four holes, being 1 ,2 ,5 & 6, If the scores are still even, a sudden death play-off will apply holes 4 &6 until a result is achieved on the day. Ties in other scratch and handicap events will be decided on a count back.
5. Divisions for both scratch and handicap shall be:
 - A Grade - 0 – 9
 - B Grade - 10 – 14
 - C Grade - 15--21
 - D Grade - 22--36
6. Handicaps – each player shall play off their original entered handicap (day 1) throughout the Championships.
7. Day one order of play, players as per time sheet.
Day two order of play, players as per time sheet.
Day three order of play, Players will be in order of progressive scratch scores. The top 8 seeded players from each grade are chosen. These hit off times will be allocated on the time sheet commencing at 11.30am, with D grade seeded players hitting first, then C grade, B Grade & A Grade. The remainder of the field will be as per time sheet.
Day four order of play, Players will be in order of progressive scratch scores. The top 8 seeded players from each grade are chosen. These hit off times will be allocated on the time sheet commencing at 11.30am, with D grade seeded players hitting first, then C grade, B Grade & A Grade.
8. Entry fee – a block entry fee of \$35.00 may be paid before the first round, giving eligibility for the 72 hole event, as well as each daily 18 hole competition. A single entry fee of \$10.00 may be paid by those wishing to only play in the daily 18 hole event.
9. The programme may be altered at the discretion of the Match Committee who shall have full control of the event and its decision shall be final.
10. Mobile phones must be switched off at all times. The audible emission and/or unauthorised use of a mobile phone on the golf course and during play may attract a warning or disqualification (Rule 33-7). However, players or caddies who have medical or serious reason to have their mobile phone switched on, must inform the Captain or Match Committee. Should the Captain/Match committee agree this reason is substantial, the player or caddie may have the phone switched on in MUTE.
11. If playing in a cart you must have a medical certificate.

DAILY CHAMPIONSHIP STROKE ROUNDS

1. Daily entrants may win one or more 18 hole events.
2. Divisions for daily events are normal domestic handicap divisions.
3. Handicaps may alter if necessary in the daily events.
4. Those who have paid the BLOCK ENTRY fee do not need to pay a daily fee, as this entry INCLUDES each daily events fee. Those wishing to only play in the 18 hole daily event must pay the normal \$10 entry fee each day
