GOLF CLUB DIRECTORS RETURNED UNOPPOSED

The results of the 2011 election for the Board of The Howlong Country Golf Club were declared at the Annual General Meeting of the Club on Monday 18th April.

There was no requirement for an election this year as the sitting members were unopposed.

The Board has indicated that they are pleased that the members have again given their support to the three year recovery program and that they are committed to achieving this year's target.

Whilst no election was contested 113 members were in attendance to participate in this important meeting dealing with issues such as changes to the constitution and the approval by members for the sale of surplus land.

The Club also has some important projects that it will be undertaking this year with the Club set to invest in a major upgrade to its irrigation system. Club General Manager Mr. Chris Rebbechi explained that *"The first stage of the project will cost between \$500,000 and \$600,000 and will be predominantly funded by the sale of general security water rights."*

Club President Ken Walton said *"the year ahead will be challenging for the Club however the systems and processes are now in place to ensure that the Club's recovery plan is successful."*
